### **Financials**

Please tie up sticks & place leaves/small yard waste in disposable bags. The crews will not collect plastic bags or sticks that are not properly tied. Also, large piles of yard waste may incur an extra charge. Pruning will take place at the end of the spring growing season (toward the end of May or early June). We will post the date on the website once it is scheduled.
