Landscaping

Peggy, Keith & Jimmy continue to meet weekly about landscaping requests with updates provided to Doris. Peggy and Doris toured the grounds recently looking for dead and dying plants. Peggy is keeping a list of all residents requesting new plants. Nothing will be planted before November as the weather is too warm.

The second of three trimmings will begin in September. Also, in September and October the grass will be aerated and seeded. A number of residents have complained about grass not growing due to tree roots and shade. An erosion expert from Chatham County reported there is no way to grow grass in many areas of WSG due to the trees.

Special Projects

The shutter project has begun & will take about six weeks. There are 77 pairs of shutters and eight repairs to shutters.
