Financials

The Communication Committee will be helpful to Bill's committee in getting information about this project to the residents affected. Much preparation is needed.

Inspection of roofs has been a topic for Bill's committee also. Community Manager Peggy Akers has received proposal from two roofers, one construction company, and an engineering firm. Bill and Peggy spoke with Kevin Giles about the roof inspections and the asphalt project. He had several excellent recommendations for both projects.
