

WSG REMINDERS: SUMMER 2022 July August September

Having **trouble with your mailbox lock**? The Postal Service will install a new lock with 3 keys. To request a new lock, you need to go to the Pittsboro Post Office (916 East Street, Pittsboro), fill out a form and pay the \$25 fee. In a few days a postal employee will install the new lock and bring the new keys to your home. That's it.

The **tropical storm season** is here. Do you know how to open your garage door if the power goes out? Instructions on how to open your garage door during a power outage are posted on our WSG website (www.weathersfieldsg.org). From the menu at the top of the home page, select Documents/Guidelines for Homeowners/Your Garage Door and What to Do When the Power Goes Out.

Reminder: Trash and recycling pickup is often postponed until Wednesday if there is a holiday on Monday or Tuesday. The remaining two Wednesday pickups for 2022 are the weeks of Independence Day (July 4) and Labor Day (September 5). Also, only plastics numbered #1 & #2 can be recycled. All other plastics should go in the trash.

Ongoing Work for Our Community

Your Weathersfield Service Group has been active with a comprehensive program of safety, preventive and general maintenance:

<u>Sidewalks</u> throughout the community were examined to identify uneven areas. Two major problem areas were repaired; other minor issues will be marked and repaired at a later date.

Pressure washing of homes and garages was completed, washing away the accumulated dust, grime and pollen.

<u>Sewer lines</u> will be examined on a four-year schedule. PureLine examined the first group of homes, and repairs were completed where necessary. The next group of homes will be examined in 2023.

Garage doors along Swim & Croquet were professionally inspected and repairs made as warranted. More garages will be inspected next year.

Pruning hedges in the common areas will continue throughout Weathersfield.
